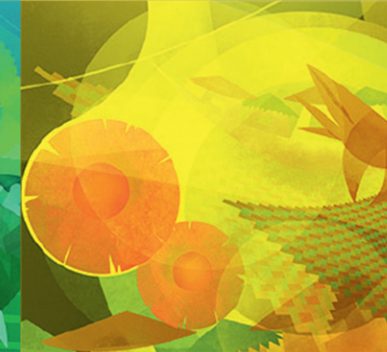
Ensuring that all learners have access to quality education that meets basic learning needs, respects diversity, and enriches their lives.
